John G. Nordling



Dr. Nordling joined the faculty of Concordia Theological Seminary, Fort Wayne, Indiana, in 2006 and serves as

professor of Exegetical Theology. He received his M.Div. from Concordia Seminary, St. Louis (1985), and has completed two additional academic degrees in Classics, at Washington University in St. Louis (M.A., 1985) and at University of Wisconsin-Madison (Ph.D., 1991). Nordling has served as a parish pastor (Grace English Evangelical Lutheran Church, Chicago, Illinois) and has taught at Valparaiso University and at Baylor University.

Dr. Nordling developed “Lutheranism & the Classics,” a biennial conference wherein pastors, classicists, and educators, consider how the classical languages have influenced the Lutheran confession and practice in the past and how Greek and Latin are poised to enrich the Church, the academy, and the culture in the future.

Dr. Nordling has written for the *Concordia Commentary Series*, and has authored the book *Religion and Resistance in Early Judaism: Greek Readings in 1 Maccabees and Josephus*, as well as academic articles on the Pauline epistles (Philemon, Philippians), slavery, and social issues. He has been married to Sara since 1985.
